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VENDOR NEED-TO-KNOW

The theme this year is Tie-Dye!

Please feel free to wear your brightest, most fun and crazy tie-dye apparel.

IMPORTANT DETAILS

- Vendors must keep everything within their assigned area.
- Vendors must provide their tent, table, and chairs.
- Vendor setup will begin at 9:30 a.m. Vendors can begin set-up after they have checked in and received their booth location. *(If more time is needed to set up, please advise)*
- Vehicles will be permitted to unload/load booth items. All vendor booths must be setup and vehicles must be removed by 11 a.m.
- All vendors are required to have at least one person at the booth at all times, as you must remain open and have merchandise available for the duration of the event.

- Vendors are responsible for disassembling and cleaning their vendor area.

MAXIMIZE YOUR EXPERIENCE

To really maximize the experience of the expo, we're asking our participating vendors to think outside the box with their booth - create a vendor experience that will leave families excited beyond what you have to sell! Here are some cool interactive booth examples, to keep in mind:

- If you are a boutique owner and have a portable apparel rack or two, bring them and hang apparel. If you have some fun, tie-dye pieces or colorful items - bring them!
- If you are selling snackable goodies, provide some free samples for tasting, a DIY recipe card or create a mini-demonstration where they see how you make it using ingredients (then allow them to sample it).
 - Remember, only food items permitted to sell are:
 - Fruits, vegetables, baked goods, honey, preserves, pickles, etc.
- If you are selling products, provide some free samples for the families to try at the table or take home with them. Or show them how to use the product in a live demonstration.
- If you're a consultant with resources, host a fun game at your booth that can help people learn more about your services, or do a giveaway. Then provide postcard sized information cards and brochures that they can easily take with them. Don't forget to attach your business card.

You can be as creative as you want! We just ask that our families be able to interact with your booth beyond purchasing your products and services. This will be the perfect opportunity for you to easily build email leads and market your products by giving the families an experience they can really enjoy.
